# Specified Professions Product for Event/Meeting/Wedding Planners

## *Claim Examples*

- ▶ SmithCo is hosting a party for their stockholders to celebrate the launch of their newest product. They hire Evan's Events to help them plan everything, and specify that they would like a photographer at the party to take pictures that will be published in SmithCo's annual report. Evan's Events hires Dave to take pictures of the party. Unfortunately, Dave has a little too much to drink during the party and causes an embarrassing scene. He takes very few pictures, none of which are suitable for publication. SmithCo later discovers that the photographer has a history of poor service. They sue Evan's Events for \$10,000 for professional negligence in selecting a photographer.
- ▶ Steve and Marie hire Sonya's Weddings to plan their wedding. They tell Sonya they would like their wedding colors to be red and black. The decorator that Sonya hires accidentally orders everything in blue and yellow. The members of the wedding party do not match the colors of anything at the reception. Steve and Marie are furious and sue Sonya's Weddings for negligence. The suit costs Sonya \$5,000 in defense costs alone.
- ▶ Ralph is going to host a continuing education seminar for 100 of his company's loyal insurance agents. His company takes care of all the transportation costs for his agents, some of whom will be flying in from all over the country. The transportation costs amount to \$12,500. He hires Evan's Events to take care of booking the convention center and the caterer. On the day of the seminar, Ralph discovers that Evan's Events has booked the convention center for the wrong date. His agents are furious. Evan's Events offers to return Ralph's deposit and reschedule the seminar, however Ralph's company will now have to pay another \$12,500 to fly his agents back for the rescheduled seminar. He sues Evan's Events for \$25,000 for the error.
- ▶ Harry's Hotel is hosting a New Year's Eve party. They hire Gary's Galas to plan the evening. Gary's Galas promises they will provide an open bar and an evening full of celebration. Harry's puts an ad in the paper advertising an open bar from 9 PM until 1:30 AM, and promptly sells all the available tickets. At 9:30 that night, Gary from Gary's Galas announces that they are out of liquor and no more drinks will be served. The partygoers are outraged and demand a refund. Harry's Hotel sues Gary's Galas for improperly estimating the amount of alcohol that was required for the party.
- ▶ Steven and Tracy hire Barbara to plan their wedding. Barbara is responsible for booking the reception hall, church, DJ, caterer, and flowers. The day of the wedding, the flowers do not arrive. They are forced to buy flowers from a local grocery store. Barbara discovers that the florist forgot to note the date of the wedding. Mike and Tracy sue Barbara for \$5,000 for the cost of the flowers.
