## Specified Professions Product for Interior Designers

### *Claim Examples*

- ▶ Bob and Sally are planning to open a restaurant. They hire Inga from Inga's Interiors to design the dining area, including tablecloths, flooring, seats, and table styles. Unfortunately, Inga orders the wrong style of tables and chairs. Bob and Sally are not able to open their restaurant on time and sue Inga for the error.
- ▶ Ron is hired to design the interior of ABC Inc. The office manager at ABC Inc. informs Ron that they will need 450 office workstations. Ron performs some calculations and determines that each workspace should be 10' by 12'. Unfortunately, Ron makes a mistake in his measurements. When the contractors deliver the workstations, they learn that the office can only accommodate 350 workstations of that size and style. There are now 100 employees without proper workstations, and ABC has to operate with a reduced workforce until the problem is rectified. ABC sues Ron for \$50,000 for the amount of income lost due to the reduced workforce.
- ▶ Beverly hires Eli to redecorate her kitchen. Eli shows Beverly some counter samples, and Beverly agrees on a \$15,000 polished marble countertop based on Eli's recommendation. Three months after the countertop is installed, Beverly finds that the countertop scratches, chips, and stains easily. She sues Eli for the cost of replacing the countertop.
- ▶ Ralph is looking to have the interior of his sporting goods store repainted. He hires Stuart to come up with a new color scheme. Unfortunately, the painters Stuart subcontracts do not show up again after their first day on the job. They leave a huge mess in several departments. This causes a great deal of confusion to Ralph's customers, and Ralph ends up having to close the store until the problem is corrected. Ralph sues Stuart for the store's lost income.
